Applicant may be a 2018 SGHS graduate, or a returning or adult student. Selection will be made by the Big Timber Creative Arts Board.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE 2018 SGHS GRADUATE: The applicant...

- 1. Must be a graduate of SGHS.
- 2. Must be actively pursuing a degree or certificate of completion at an accredited college, university, or business or vocational school in the arts.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE RETURNING OR ADULT STUDENT: The applicant...

- 1. Must have completed or is completing a year of education beyond high school at an accredited college, university, or business or vocational school in the arts.
- 2. Must be actively pursuing a degree or certificate of completion.

STANDARDS FOR SELECTION: The BTCA Board will consider (in order of importance)

- 1. The applicant's ability to complete the proposed program.
- 2. The applicant's community involvement.
- 3. The applicant's financial need.
- 4. The applicant's academic achievement.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Complete the attached application form.
- 2. Include a copy of your college or vocational school transcript or a copy of your most recent grade report.
- 3. If visual or literary arts, a photograph or sample of your visual or literary art.

Payment of the scholarship funds will be made directly to the school the applicant will be attending. Failure to remain in good standing with that institution will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.

Applications need to be returned to the SGHS guidance office or the SG Community Foundation office by April 16, 2018.

The scholarship committee will notify applicants of its decision no later than May 1, 2018.
